A state-wide initiative was recently launched to help bridge this gap. *Virginia is for Entrepreneurs* (VA4E) connects entrepreneurs seeking financing with investors looking for opportunities and support resources for entrepreneurs. Through its website, the program links entrepreneurs with more than 50 investment firms and potential funders to help start and grow their Virginia-based businesses. The program identifies the strengths and weaknesses of the venture from an investor's perspective. This critical analysis helps the entrepreneur retool and refocus their strategy in order to accelerate the investment process and grow the business.

Partners in the network include a number of universities, including Virginia Tech; angel investment groups such as 757 Angels and Shenandoah Valley Angel Investors; venture funds including Revolution and Village Capital; and statewide organizations including the Center for Innovative Technology.
