

# CITY BUSINESSES SHINE & TAKE HOME TOP CHAMBER AWARDS



Manassas Business of the Year: Northern Virginia Community College - Manassas Campus

On Tuesday evening February 26, 2019 the Prince William County Chamber of Commerce hosted its 8th annual business awards dinner at the Hylton Performing Arts Center in Manassas to honor the best of the local business community. Awards recognize excellence in business, innovative practices, outstanding contributions to the community and businesses/organizations that stand out among their peers.

The City of Manassas presented its "Business of the Year Award" to Northern Virginia Community College - Manassas Campus. Northern Virginia Community College - Manassas Campus is leading the charge to strengthen Northern Virginia's technology workforce and create a robust talent pipeline to fill these new jobs being created in Manassas. For almost 50 years, NOVA has been a tremendous partner in the community, continually retooling and aligning its programs and services to meet evolving industry demands.
