In doing so, officials not only put protections in place for maintaining the historic home but also added much needed parkland for residents and visitors to Manassas. What was once a summer home for the Prussian-born entrepreneur and Alexandria brewer will soon be open to the public to enjoy for years to come.

Located at 9201 Maple Street, the grounds at "Annaburg Park" will open for passive recreation this fall. Public input will be sought for the longer term vision of the park and the City hopes to partner with a non-profit to restore the historic home to its former glory and create an intimate events venue. In the meantime, you can enjoy a lunchtime picnic, an afternoon stroll or perhaps an employee outing.
