

2021 Q1 MARKET REPORT




After a truly challenging year, 2021 is off to an encouraging start. New businesses continue to open, existing businesses have announced expansions and most residents have returned to work. Vacancies in each of the commercial sectors improved or remained stable from 2020 Q4, resting well within healthy averages. The City's industrial and flex product remains the most in-demand with just under three percent vacancy and rents continue to rise. The retail sector, which was arguably the hardest hit last year, has continued to rebound. We're hopeful this trend will continue as the warmer months arrive and indoor capacity restrictions are offset by expanded outdoor dining areas at many Manassas restaurants.




